Dear Pastors, Youth ministers, and Christian leaders,

I am coming to you begging for help. This past session our Texas legislature failed to pass any bills which would protect minor children from puberty-blockers, cross-sex hormones, and surgeries resulting in sterilization and removal of healthy body parts in an attempt to “change” a child’s sex. These practices are barbaric and are quickly escalating in Texas, as we now have over 16 clinics providing these services to children in our state!

Any church youth director will tell you kids are struggling with their gender and sexual identities in record numbers, and our children are suffering higher rates of anxiety, depression and suicidal ideation. There are a number of factors, but a major one is the erosion of the Judeo-Christian foundation our county was built upon. This is no accident; we are in a war.

Two sources of attack on children today are Critical Race Theory and the LGBT movement. Both call into question and seek to erode identity, critical thinking ability, and deny any objective truth about the creation and purpose of man. Instead, feelings are promoted as reality, and hedonism is celebrated. This rips the fabric of our social order and will destroy our nation.

Critical Race Theory presupposes that a white child is automatically a racist, just because of skin color, and will oppress those of color. Children of color are told they are victims. So, a child needs to be reeducated that they are either “oppressed”, or, if they are white, to not be an “oppressor.” This is now taking place in our Texas public schools and many private ones.

Transgenderism advocates believe that one can be born in the “wrong body,” or that it is possible to transition from one’s biological sex to the other with not only no consequences, but that this results in optimal human functioning. This of course is a lie from the pit of hell, but is being taught, among other erroneous sexual material, beginning in kindergarten in public schools and many private ones. Going further, children are being sexualized not only through this curriculum, but through children’s television programming and the culture in general. The next taboo to fall will be pedophilia as the concept of consent is expanded to accommodate young ages.

Both of these agendas are part of a political movement meant to fuel revolution and the breakdown of our society. The means is destroying the foundational identities and social structures of our nation: Christianity and the traditional family. Critical Race Theory is a secular theory devoid of repentance and reconciliation. Transgenderism is narcissistic and self-destructive. Governor Abbott has called a Special Session, and there is talk that he may call for more legislation against Critical Race Theory. Here is what you can do, but TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE as Special Session begins July 8:

1. Write letters to Governor Abbott and your elected officials as a church, asking for bans on CRT and medical sex change procedures for children. Invite your congregation to sign the letters.
2. Contact your local State Representative and Senator, asking them to publicly commit to fighting for these two issues.
3. Send your youth directors, pastors, and congregants to Austin during the Special Session, to meet with elected officials. (I only saw two pastors there during regular session.)
4. Write op-eds for your local papers.
5. Speak to your congregation on these two issues.
6. Schedule speakers or conferences.
7. Participate in local school board meetings to fight this curriculum in schools.
8. Most importantly, encourage your church to PRAY that God will forgive our silence and ignorance until now and give us courage to protect our children. Then, put feet to your prayers!

Yes, you will get attacked for taking a stand, and you may be picketed or targeted in some other manner. I think we have been told this would happen and given an example of Someone who loved us enough to endure just that. But what is the cost if we do not?
