Rule No. 13 – Convention Quorum – Adjournment

- c. State Convention – A quorum to convene the State Convention shall consist of a majority of the delegates registered as attending. Thereafter, a quorum shall be considered present as long as:
1. The number of votes represented by delegates in attendance comprises more than fifty percent (50%) of the total voting strength of the Convention;
 2. A majority of the seated districts are present; and
 3. One-third (1/3) of the seated delegates are present.

For #1 - more than 50% of the total voting strength of Convention was present as total Voting Strength based on Ballots presented was 8734 out of 9000 votes or 97.04%

For #2 - at least 221 out of 295 district delegations (SD/County Combinations) were present or 74.9% of the number of delegations. There were actually less than 295 seated delegations so more than the majority of districts seated were present

For #3 - 3,436 ballots were submitted and there were 5,301 delegates registered/seated based on data from David Wylie, Credentials Chairman. Thus, at least 64.8% of the seated delegates were still present during the voting process. This is more than 1/3 of the seated delegates needed.
